## MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH RESEARCH

Monthly report in the format on important issues/ developments for the month of March, 2022 is submitted herewith for kind perusal.

- 1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:
  - a) Global coronavirus COVID-19 management and measures in India: Following new measures and initiatives were taken besides the timely COVID-19 testing and reporting.
  - 1) Expansion of COVID-19 testing facilities: A total of 25 new testing labs (5 Govt. and 20 Private) were approved for covid-19 testing during the month. Accordingly, a total of 2,10,45,044 samples have been tested during the month and the testing capacity was increased up to more than 20,00,000/day.
  - 2) Approved a total of 3331 (1429 Governments and 1902 Private) Labs for COVID-19 testing.
    - -Real-Time RT PCR for COVID-19: 2207(Govt: 784 +Private: 1423)
    - TrueNat Test for COVID-19: 955 (Govt: 593+ Private: 359)
    - CBNAAT Test for COVID-19: 131(Govt: 42 + Private: 89)
    - -Other Molecular-Nucleic Acid (M-NA) Testing Platforms for COVID-19: 41(Govt: 10 + Private: 31)

- 6) Initiated study on Evaluation of Immunogenicity of ChAdOx1 nCoV-19 (Covishield) vaccine in Adults with Diabetes.
- 7) Conducted multiple data monitoring/hand holding sessions on "Registry for COVID-19 infected pregnant women and neonates".
- b) Published policy on Biomedical Innovation & Entrepreneurship for Medical Professionals, Scientists and Technologists at Medical, Dental, Para-Medical Institutes/Colleges.

- c) Operationalized and launched ICMR-DHR-Large Animal House facility centre for excellence at AMTZ, Andhra Pradesh.
- d) Launched the Online Certificate Course on Cervical Cancer Screening for Pathologists.
- e) Launched CMR-NIAID-BMGF Clinical Research Fellowship Programme with Indo-US collaboration.
- f) Obtained Indian Patent on "A process for the preparation of a fibronylytic enzyme"
- **g) Obtained copyright on** "Fever tracker app for the health workers" registration no. SW-15093/2022.
- h) Organized 'Mega Science Week under the 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav' at Chennai, Dibrugarh, Gorakhpur, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Puducherry, Puri-Odisha through deliberation on Next 25 Years of Indian Science & Technology; and partnered in Vigyan Sarvatra Pujyathe-National Science Week Festival 2022, New Delhi and "displayed the Personal Cooling Garment (PCG) technology and other technologies.
- i) 27<sup>th</sup> Technical Appraisal Committee for evaluation of New Health Technologh Assessment (HTA) proposals was conducted on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2022. The Annual Resource Centre Review Meeting was conducted to discuss the progress of all 18 resource centres on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of March, 2022.
